**3. To consider Planning Applications:**

**3.1. 3PL/2011/0118/F Leggates Farmhouse, Church Road, Thompson, IP24 1QF:**

The members asked Mr Madge to explain the proposed changes to the property.

It was noted that the a condition of the original permission for the development of the barn was: “ *The development hereby permitted shall be occupied solely as an addition to the main dwelling, and shall not at any time be sold, leased or sub-leased for occupation as a separate dwelling unit. Reason for condition: To define the permission.* ” It was felt by a majority of members that the changes were acceptable but that the Cartshed would be better either attached to or positioned very close to the barn so that it did not detract from the views of this very attractive property. Mr Madge said that the views expressed by the Thompson Councillors regarding the positioning of the Cartshed coincided with his and those of the applicant.

A majority of the members present voted in favour of acceptance of the application and the clerk was instructed to draft a reply to Breckland Council indicating support for this application but expressing their views regarding the positioning of the Cartshed on the plot.
