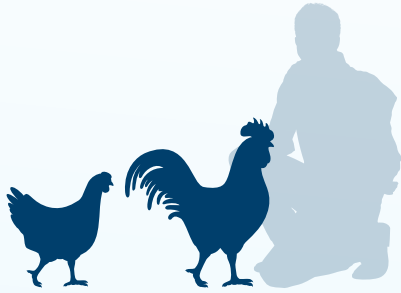


# Do you keep chickens, ducks, geese... ?

Help protect your birds from the risk of **bird flu**



## Remember

Any very sick birds, or unexplained deaths, must be assessed by your vet. By law suspicion of bird flu is notifiable and can affect poultry movement and trade.



## Tip 1: Cleaning

Wash hands thoroughly and clean footwear before and after visiting your birds. Keep areas clean and tidy, regularly disinfect hard surfaces. Use a Defra approved disinfectant. Humanely control rats and mice.



## Tip 2: Feeding

Minimise direct and indirect contact between poultry, captive birds and wild birds. Make sure all feed and water is inaccessible to wild birds and remove spilled feed regularly.



## Tip 3: Stay aware
